



Dress Code Policy

General dress consists of **solid colored** tops, skirts, pants, or shorts (when deemed season appropriate), with absolutely no writing on any articles of clothing. We will not allow any articles of clothing that display any logos (brand names, educational facilities, sports teams, etc.) even if covered or masked in some way. For this reason, we have a list of appropriate and acceptable attire from L.L.Bean that is available upon request (Design #52224). Please ask the Director of Admissions for this list. All items on that list meet the criteria stated below. The only items that are required to be purchased from L.L.Bean are khaki pants/shorts, and items with the Greenbrier Academy logo embroidered: two polos and one fleece. Of course, students are allowed to have any items embroidered with the Greenbrier Academy logo, but no monogramming is allowed. **In order to ensure a smooth transition into Greenbrier Academy, appropriate clothing must be brought the day of arrival.**

Dress Code Guidelines

Tops: Tops must be long enough that the midriff is never exposed. Sleeves are required. Necklines may come no lower than four fingers below the collarbone.

Skirts: Hemlines or slits should never come higher than the bottom of the knee.

Pants: Loose-fitting pants may be worn. Loose-fitting jeans may be worn when deemed appropriate. Low-riders are not permitted. Shorts may be worn when seasonally appropriate, shortest acceptable length is two inches above the knee.

Active/Sleep Wear: All top, bottom, and ease guidelines apply to active and sleep wear.

Footwear: Soft soled shoes (such moccasins, sneakers, tennis shoes, Uggs or Crocs) are required to wear in the buildings and to class. Sandals may be worn within the residence hall. Slippers are also allowed in the residence hall and encouraged. Hiking boots or shoes are permitted for outdoor activities.

Jewelry: Post earrings may be worn only in the lobe of the ear (maximum of one matched sets). One ring, one necklace, one watch, and one bracelet are also permitted. All other types of body piercing are prohibited.

Ease: All dresses, skirts, pants, and shirts must be loose fitting, having a minimum of three inches of ease at bust and hips. An informal way to measure ease is to stand up straight and pinch the loose fabric on both sides of the hips or at the bust line. Without stretching the fabric, there should be at least a 3/4-inch fold of fabric on both sides.

Other: Sheer clothing is not permitted. Hairstyles should be neat, orderly, and feminine. Excessive makeup is not permitted.

Purely for space purposes Greenbrier suggests that students bring no more than the following amounts of clothing. The Residential Coordinator must approve more clothes than this, or the clothes will be boxed up and sent home. Greenbrier Academy is not responsible for the loss or destruction of any student’s personal property. Parents should not send items of high monetary value to their child. Greenbrier Academy will return expensive and inappropriate items at the cost of the parent.
